
Blue Mountain Community Library Christmas Tree Fundraiser

Bangor Area School District Educational Foundation Awards \$7,000 in Teacher Grants to Fund Special Projects

By Deanna Ruzanski, Executive Director Bangor Area School District Educational Foundation The Bangor Area School District Educational Foundation, whose goal is to enhance the educational quality of students and improve the overall community, awarded \$7,000 in teacher grants to fund special projects in the Bangor Area School District for the 2017-2018 academic vear.

Through the Foundation's fund-raising efforts and investment success, the Teacher Grant Program was made available for the first time this year. The Teacher Grant program is intended to cover initiatives and programs that are outside of the typical school budget. Fourteen applications were received after board members from The Foundation presented the Teacher Grant Program to the faculty at each of the five schools last spring. A committee, which consisted of four board members from The Foundation, reviewed each application and chose the recipients based on the overall impact for the students and community as well as the creative and innovative aspects of each program. This year's recipients and their programs are as follows: Patricia Rutt, 5 Points Elementary: Mobile Agricultural Education Science Lab; Angela Ronco, DeFranco Elementary: Science in the House; Adam Raines, Senior High: Virtual Business Sports & Entertainment Program in Marketing Class; James Burke DeFranco, 5 Points and Washington Elementary: Programming in the Classroom; Angela Ronco, DeFranco Elementary: Accessing Text for all Students.

Angela Ronco, a fifth grade teacher at DeFranco Elementry, who received two grants this year said, "Thanks to the generosity of the BASD Education Foundation, the 5th grade language arts classrooms at DeFranco have received listening centers! The students enjoy listening to books with their peers for enjoyment, and the centers are also very helpful to allow students to experience books that may be above their independent reading level. The centers are very useful for differentiating reading materials and allowing student access to books on their level. Children at all levels love to be read to, so they really enjoy the listening centers."

The Bangor Area School District Educational Foundation, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non-profit educational organization. Founded in the Spring of 1997. The Foundation's mission is to support learning for the children and adults of the Bangor Area School District by funding activities and culturally enriching programs, community events, student scholarships, teacher grant projects and academic awards. The Foundation oversees the financial aspect of the various scholarships that are presented to district students each year. The two largest awards are the Wolf and Trigiani scholarships. Scholarships and the Teacher Grant program are made available through donor contributions and fundraising efforts of The Foundation. Hunters Can Share their Harvests

To help families, individuals and seniors who are in need, the Hunters Sharing the Harvest (HSH) program has encouraged hunters from across the Commonwealth to share their deer harvest and provide thousands of pounds of venison.

The program partners with the Pennsylvania Game Commission, Department of Agriculture and many other sportsmen and charitable organizations. Since 1991, HSH has distributed more than 1.2 million pounds of donated venison.

Hunters can donate all or part of a harvested deer by taking it to a participating processor, which will then distribute the ground venison to food banks and pantries. In an average hunting season, the HSH program's goal is to channel about 100,000 pounds of processed venison through the state's 20 regional food banks, which then redistribute to more than 5,000 local provider charities such as food pantries, missions, homeless shelters and churches, as well as individual families.



One Room School House to Get Facelift

It has long been the goal of the Bangor Area School District and its community to revitalize the One Room School House that sits on Five Points Richmond Road in front of the Bangor Area High School. The lessons of history and the heritage of the Slate Belt have always played an important role in the community. The One Room School House stands as a reminder



that history is important and never forgotten.

The One Room School House served the District beginning in 1858 making the building One hundred sixty years old. This style of school building used to be common and there may have been up to twenty-six



schoolhouses in the area that now comprises the Bangor Area School District. Today, the One Room School House is one of only a handful of remaining structures making it vital that we preserve this structure. Jeff Ott, P.E. of Ott Consulting Inc.,

Mike Ortoski, Editor of the Blue Valley Times, and Frank Brooks teamed up with school district Administrators William Haws, superintendent, and Bradon Hendershot Assistant to the Superintendent to determine what could be done to save this remarkable building.

It was hoped that not only could the building be restored but that it would once again serve the District as it had in the past.

Frank Brooks took the initiative to write a grant proposal while Mike Ortoski posted a request for letters of support on the Blue Valley Times website. Thanks to all of the concerned citizens and the efforts of all

involved. Northampton County awarded \$15,000 toward the restoration of the One Room School House.

The Bangor Area School District will now begin its work to determine what work needs to be done to restore the structure. In addition, tests for lead-



Ingredients needed:

1/3 c. sugar

1/3 c. packed brown sugar

3/4 c. all-purpose flour

1/2 tsp. baking powder

1/8 tsp. baking soda

1/8 tsp. salt

1 cup quick-cooking oats

1 cup dried cranberries

1 cup vanilla chips

1/2 cup butter, melted

1 egg

1 tsp. vanilla extract



Directions:

In a quart size glass jar, layer the sugar and brown sugar packing well between layers.

Combine the flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt and spoon into jar. Top with oats, cranberries and chips. Cover with lid.

To make cookies: Pour cookie mix into a large mixing bowl; stir to combine. Beat in butter, egg and vanilla. Cover and refrigerate for 30 minutes.

Drop by tablespoonfuls 2 inches apart onto ungreased baking sheets.

Bake at 375°F for 8-10 min, or until browned. Remove to wire racks to cool.

Keep Your Pets Safe this Holiday Season

The holidays are a time to be merry and festive, but they are also a time that pose potential dangers to your pet. A few simple precautions can avoid potential holiday mishaps and ensure the safety of your four legged family members.

TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR PETS THIS HOLIDAY SEASON:

- **1. Ornaments and Tinsel** Although tinsel is not toxic it can still be very dangerous if ingested by your pet. Cats especially love tinsel. If your cat consumes tinsel and it is not caught in a timely manner this could be fatal.
- 2. Lights and Candles Candles need to be placed where pets do not have access to them. Knocking over a candle can not only create a potential fire, pets can also burn their paws on the hot wax. The shiny holiday lights entice curious pets. Make sure to keep all lights out of a pets reach and frequently check for signs of chewing or fraying on the lights to make sure that pets who like to chew are not in danger of electrical shock.
- 3. Toxic Holiday Plants Many holiday plants are poisonous. Some holiday plants are not only poisonous but may even be deadly to your pet. Some plants may cause vomiting and diarrhea while others may cause organ failure and even death. Poinsettias, Mistletoe, Holly and some form of Lilies are a few of the most common poisonous plants. It's best to keep your pet away from all holiday plants including your Christmas tree.
- 4. Christmas Trees Although not poisonous Christmas trees can still pose a potentential hazard to your pet. Pine needles can cause oral irritation to the mouth and digestive tract. The needles are also indigestible and may be very painful for your pet to pass. Do not decorate your tree with any food. Popcorn, candy canes, gingerbread cookies are all a temptation to your pet. They may be a treat for you but could cause an upset stomach or even a blockage for your pet.
- 5. Food We all love the holidays and the special foods and sweets the season brings. These treats can be very harmful to your pets. Chocolate a favorite for many during the holiday season but not so for your pet if ingested. Chocolate (especially dark and baking chocolate), can be very toxic to your pet if ingested. The darker the chocolate the higher the risk of toxicity. Nuts another popular treat during the holidays. Nuts should not be given to your pet as they can cause an upset stomach or get lodged in your dog's throat or intestinal tract. Certain nuts can be toxic, causing seizures or neurological signs. Vomiting, lethargy, and loss of muscle control are some of the effects of nut ingestion by a dog. Other foods to keep away from pets are alcohol, fatty foods, and foods and beverages with caffeine. It is best to stick to your pets regular diet even during the holiday season.


