The Slate Belt Heritage Center & Museum will hold their The Memorial Library of Nazareth and Vicinity will host its Veterans' Day Program on Sunday, November 9, 2:00PM. Speaker for the afternoon will be Mr. Dane DiFebo who will present: "Understanding the 153rd Pennsylvania Infantry through Artifacts and Documents". Dane will speak about the Pennsylvania 153rd Civil War Regiment. He will address how the officers and enlisted men of "Northampton County's Own" nine month volunteer infantry regiment contributed to the Union cause in the American Civil War by describing artifacts and accounts that they left behind. Dane has studied the 153rd for nearly thirty years. He has several ancestors that have served in Upper Mt. Bethel's Company G and has amassed a collection of objects related to the regiment and the regions' Civil War response. 


