



Slate Belt Heritage Center Will Present a Program on "Scuba Diving in the Delaware and Lehigh Rivers"

The Slate Belt Heritage Center will present an interesting program titled"Scuba Diving in the Delaware and Lehigh Rivers" on **Thursday, August 8th at 7:00PM**. Speaker Joe Fiorention will share his experiences scuba diving in the Delaware and Lehigh Rivers and speak about the wildlife and history of popular diving sites. Topics to be shared include the wildlife in the Delaware Water Gap, remains of the collapsed bridge from the 1955 Floods under the Northampton Street Bridge (Free Bridge) in Easton and prohibition era artifacts from the Lehigh River in Bethlehem.

Joe Fiorention is an accomplished SCUBA instructor and shipwreck explorer. He has led divers to many of the popular wrecks off the coast of New Jersey, as well as expeditions to Nova Scotia Canada to locate


