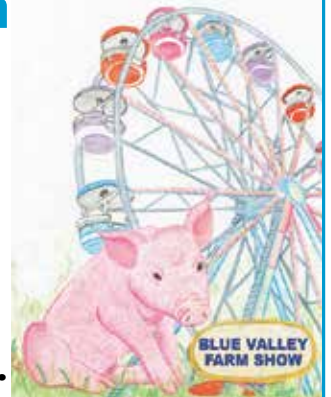

Plan for a Year of Celebrations and Hot Air Balloons In Warren County, New Jersey!

This year Warren County, New Jersey, has been in celebratory mood, and there is a lot more to celebrate! It was 25 years ago the first Hot Air Balloon Festival was held at the Warren County Farmers' Fair in Harmony Township. In 2020, the festival was held at Warren Community College, Washington campus, as one of the only events to take place during the Covid pandemic. The relocation was intended for only one year but new traditions arose (literally) in the County, with the addition of two more balloon festivals. As if that's not enough to celebrate, Warren County is marking its Bicentennial this year.

Fred Grotenhuis, one of the earliest balloon pilots in the area, had the vision of launching a hot air balloon festival at the county fair. Fred was a lifelong resident of Harmony Township, with the exception of during his service as a US Army helicopter pilot during the Vietnam war era. He fondly remembered attending the local Fair each year as a youth, and his love of the Fair inspired him to establish a balloon festival at the event. He would say, "The infrastructure is already there and hot air balloons would bring people back to the Fair." He was right. Fred is no longer with us, but his vision for balloon festival at the fair and his spirit for adventure live on, 25 years later!

Today there are three balloon festivals held annually in the County, but none bigger than at the the Warren County Farmers' Fair—the original host. The Fair is celebrating 87 years of providing affordable family fun and tradition for generations of families. Admission, that includes Fair and balloon festival, runs an adult \$10 and \$5 for youth ages 6 to 12, with free admission for ages 5 and under, for veterans on Sunday, for Seniors on Monday and free parking all week long. The event runs from **Saturday, July 26 through Saturday, August 2.**

One could say July 2021 was the birth of the balloon festivals in Warren County. To celebrate 25 years of the original Hot Air Balloon Festival at the Warren County Farmers' Fair, they are bringing in a hot air balloon shaped like a big birthday cake for the occasion. This special balloon stands 80 feet tall and weighs over 800 pounds!

The balloons, for sure, are a crowd pleaser and one of the main attractions of the Fair. Other highlights include Main Arena Power events like Demolition Derbies, Truck and Tractor Pulls and a Rodeo (some require tickets). Weeklong there are carnival rides, traditional arts expo, beer tent, local bands, line and square dancing on select nights, and lots of great Fair food options. Visiting the Kids' Corral free children's activity area is a must if you have little ones. Shows, contests, craft making and educational presentations. Also enjoy seeing the hard work of locals in the Home and Garden Building, of 4-H and FFA students in various buildings, and a variety of car, truck and tractor shows.

Download the brochure at www.warrencountymarkersfair.org and plan your visit accordingly.

And if you miss the Fair or if you can't get enough of hot air balloons, the final festival is the Warren County Hot Air Balloons, Fun & Games Festival, on **September 20-21**, at Warren Community College. We've got a lot to celebrate this year in Warren County, New Jersey. Hope to see you celebrating along with us this year and for years to come!

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2nd Annual Pocono Mountains Flight Fest

The 2nd Annual Pocono Mountains Flight Fest will be held on **August 9, from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm** at the Pocono Mountains Regional Airport. The event will include Touch-A-Truck; airplane and antique car displays; a children's area with hayrides, bouncy house and a candy drop; food trucks where guests can purchase food and drink; music and paid airplane and helicopter rides benefitting the Vern Moyer Aviation Fund. Parking is \$10 per car.

The Vern Moyer Aviation Fund was established in memory of aviation advocate and mentor in the Mid-Atlantic region – Vern Moyer. Paul Morgan of Moyer Aviation, comments, "We established the event last year in memory of Vern to raise money to provide scholarships for students interested in pursuing a career in aviation whether it be flying or mechanics. We raised over \$30,000 for the Fund and have selected it again for 2025 to be the primary beneficiary."

Morgan continues, "Vern loved bringing the community into the airport to get them involved with aviation. We have created the day to include kids activities, an area to purchase from food truck vendors, displays of trucks, antique cars, and aircraft, and the opportunity to see the Pocono Mountains from the sky with helicopter and airplane rides."

The Vern Moyer Aviation Scholarship Fund has been established to support the development, educational opportunities, and preservation of aviation across Pennsylvania. It seeks to elevate public awareness and inspire individuals to pursue careers in aviation, offer scholarships to individuals pursuing a career in aviation, provide resources and technology to support learning in aviation, endeavors that safeguard aviation heritage, and promote advancements in aviation technology.

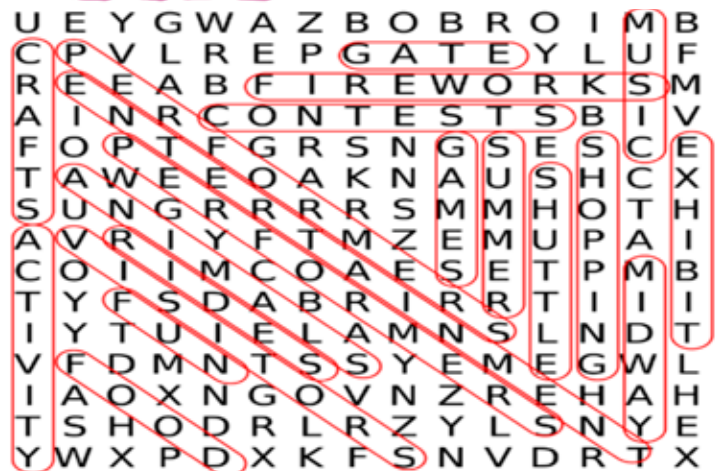
