



**American Kestrels Call Grand Central Home**  
**Local Bird Bander helps Grand Central Landfill's Habitat**

Paul Karner of Bangor, a local U.S. Federal bird bander, as well as Jere Schade of Bucks County banded five American Kestrel birds on Thursday at the Grand Central Landfill. The Kestrels, approximately two



weeks old, were banded with small numbered aluminum-alloy bands.

The data collected will be provided to the North American Bird Banding Program's Bird Banding Laboratory run by the U.S. Department of the Interior. Banding has led to more knowledge about the migratory habits of the birds.

"The bands work similar to a social security number for the birds. When someone finds a bird with a band on it, they input the band number into the bird banding laboratory website and all the information about that bird shows up," said Karner.

The American Kestrels have been pairing up since 2006 and nesting in the box near Grand Central's Wastewater Treatment plant. The habitat also attracts Bluebirds and Tree Swallows, both of which Paul bands yearly at the facility.

The banding program is part of Grand Central's commitment to conserve open space and is a component of the sites' Wildlife Habitat Council certification.

"Our facility has been certified by the Wildlife Habitat Council since 2007. Paul has been a partner from the beginning and we are very thankful for his help and knowledge as we continue to further our habitat programming," said Landfill Manager Ron Myer.

Mr. Karner's conservation work isn't just at the landfill, he also monitors and maintains 109 American Kestrel boxes in Eastern Northampton County. His work dates back to the 1970's when he became interested in banding.

"I enjoyed it so much that I became a Master Bird Bander, operating my own banding station with apprentices under me." Said Karner.

Grand Central's habitat program expanded in 2007 to include an education center on the facility's property. Since its inception, children and adults from around the area have participated in nearly 100 education programs.


