Slate Belt Girl Scouts Pollinator Garden

Slate Belt Girl Scout Troops 8320 and 80, along with family and friends, recently partnered with Roseto Borough Mayor Ilene Tillman to update a wooded section at the Roseto Park and develop it into a pollinator garden for the community to enjoy.



This project is part of Brownie Troops 80 and 8320 "Think Like a Citizen: Scientist Journey" as well as the National Wildlife Federation's Mayor's Monarch Pledge which calls for a commitment to creating habitats for the Monarch butterfly, as well as other pollinators and wildlife, and educating the community on how to create welcoming environments for pollinators.



The troops, along with families and friends, Mayor Tillman, and Penn State Master Gardener Karen Lane, weeded the area, cleared out debris and rocks, and planted pollinator bushes and flowers. Scouts sourced items from local businesses, community members, and their family and friends. Waste Management donated garden tools, gloves, garbage bags, and landscape fabric. ACE Hardware in Bangor donated a birdbath, Ginder Greenhouse and Garden Center gave 2 beautiful butterfly bushes, John Teague from East Bangor donated a truckload of wood chips, Lowes in Whitehall gave 11 perennial plants, Walmart in Easton donated 4 plants and Troop 8340 donated birdhouses, bee houses and butterfly houses.

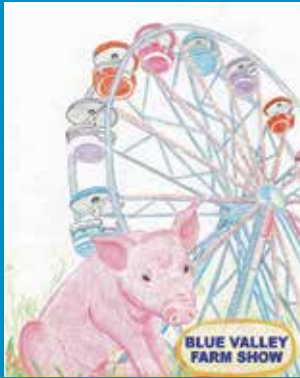
