Sweet Potato Bites

PREP:15 minutes COOK:35 minutes SERVES:Makes 15-20

These sweet potato bites will be a hit as an appetizer or a quick treat!

INGREDIENTS

2-3 Medium Sweet
 Potatoes5-6 Large Marshmallows15-20 Pecan Halves2 tbsp. melted butter1 tsp. maple syrup

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 400°

Peel sweet potatoes and slice 1/4 -1/2 inch thick.

Slice each marshmallow into 3 pieces.

Toss sweet potatoes

with melted butter and maple syrup and season with salt.

Arrange in an even layer on a baking sheet.

Bake for 10 minutes. Flip slices and bake 10 more minutes.

Top sweet potatoes with marshmallow slices and broil on high for 30-60 seconds or until lightly browned.

Remove from oven and immediately top with pecan halves. Serve.
