### Easy Apple Crisp Ingredients:

1/2 cup all purpose flour  
1 cup old fashioned rolled oats  
3/4 cup packed brown sugar  
1 tsp ground cinnamon  
1/4 tsp nutmeg  
1/4 tsp salt  
1/2 cup cold butter, cut into cubes



### APPLE FILLING

5 cups thinly sliced granny smith apples  
(about 4 large apples)  
1/4 cup packed brown sugar  
2 tbsp butter, melted  
2 tbsp all purpose flour  
2 tsp lemon juice  
3/4 tsp ground cinnamon  
1/4 tsp nutmeg  
Pinch of salt

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
2. Add all of the ingredients for the topping, except for the butter, to a medium sized bowl and stir to combine.
3. Add the cold butter and use a pastry cutter or fork to cut the butter into the dry ingredients until the mixture is crumbly and comes together. Set aside.
4. Combine all the ingredients for the apples and stir together so that the apples are well coated, then pour the mixture into an 8 or 9 inch square dish.
5. Sprinkle the topping evenly over the apples.
6. Bake for about 40 minutes, until the topping is golden around the edges and the apples are tender. Allow to cool for about 15 minutes prior to serving.

### Tips for the Best Apple Crisp

Be sure to slice your apples thin so they become fully tender. No crunchy apples in apple crisp.  
Stick with granny smith apples for best results.  
Serve homemade apple crisp freshly baked and warm.  
Top with vanilla ice-cream or caramel sauce and enjoy!

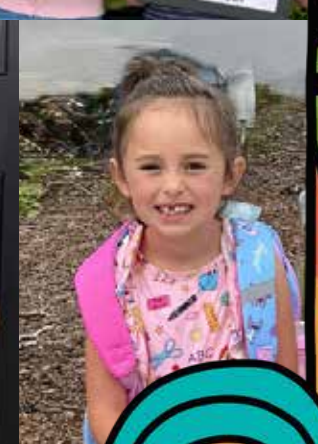

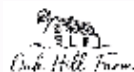
