Northampton County Elections Office Poll Workers Needed for Upcoming Election Tuesday, November 4, 2025

Northampton County Elections Office reminds registered voters who live in Northampton County that they are seeking workers for poll worker positions for the upcoming Municipal General Election on **Tuesday, November 4th**.

Every year, elections in Northampton County are made possible by citizens who serve as poll workers. These people do the important work of checking in voters at polling places and setting them up with a ballot. At the end of the night, poll workers deliver the returns to county election officials. The County depends on these workers to ensure fair, accurate, and legal elections.

Poll workers must attend mandatory training prior to the Primary Election and are also paid for their training time and work on Election Day. Northampton County poll workers may earn between \$175 and \$200 for serving all of Election Day, depending on the poll worker's assignments and training. Typical Election Day hours are from 6:30 a.m. until after the polls close at 8 p.m. Individuals who bring supplies back to the Government Center receive additional compensation and mileage.

Slate Belt Heritage Center & Museum Veterans Day Program

The Slate Belt Heritage Center & Museum will hold their Veterans' Day Program on **Sunday, November 9, 2:00PM**. Speaker for the afternoon will be Mr. Dane DiFebo who will present: **"Understanding the 153rd Pennsylvania Infantry through Artifacts and Documents"**. Dane will speak about the Pennsylvania 153rd Civil War Regiment. He will address how the officers and enlisted men of "Northampton County's Own" nine month volunteer infantry regiment contributed to the Union cause in the American Civil War by describing artifacts and accounts that they left behind. Dane has studied the 153rd for nearly thirty years. He has several ancestors that have served in Upper Mt. Bethel's Company G and has amassed a collection of objects related to the regiment and the regions' Civil War response. For nearly nine years, Dane was employed as the Director of Education & Programs at the National Civil War Museum in Harrisburg, PA and has served as the Pennsylvania Department Commander of "The Sons of the Union Veterans of the Civil War" being a contributing member of Bangor's Joel Searfoss camp of the Sons of Union Volunteers since 2000. The program is free and open to the public. All Veterans are welcome to attend. The Heritage Center & Museum is located at 30 North 1st Street, Bangor, PA. 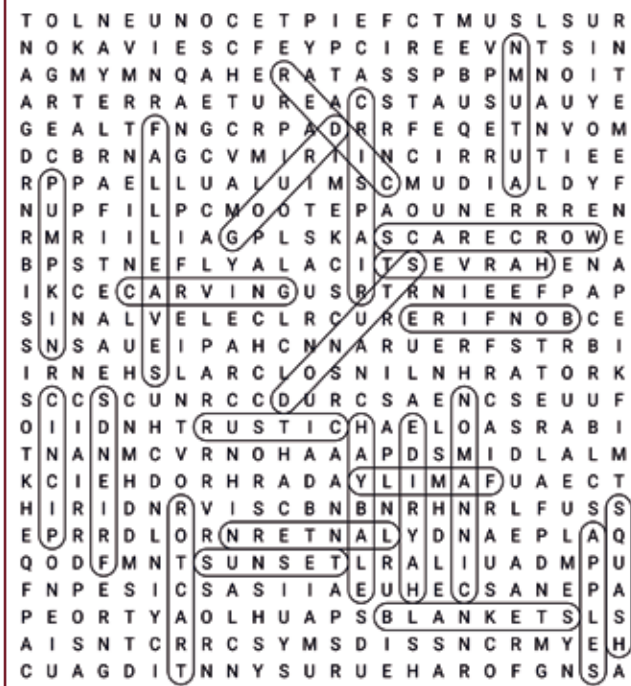

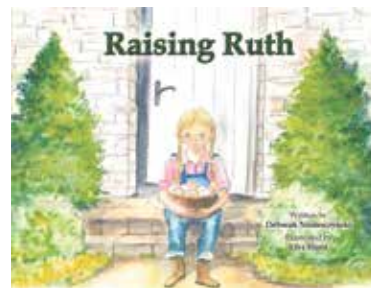

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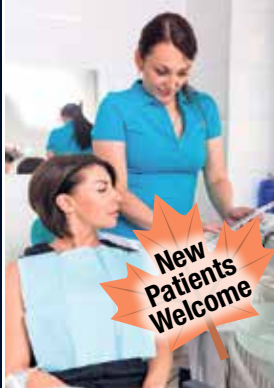
