

Blue Valley Farm Show Youth Livestock Sale Partners with Feeding Pennsylvania to Support Local Families

The Blue Valley Farm Show Youth Livestock Sale reached a new milestone this year with the announcement of a cooperative effort with Feeding Pennsylvania, creating an even greater impact on the community during Saturday's sale on August 16.

The annual Youth Livestock Sale is a long-standing tradition at the Blue Valley Farm Show, giving Northampton County 4-H members the opportunity to sell the livestock they've raised as part of their yearly projects. Buyers can purchase animals outright, provide "add-on" contributions above market value to support the young exhibitors, or donate the livestock to local food banks.

This year's new partnership with Feeding Pennsylvania ensured that donated animals would be processed and distributed directly to food banks across the state, supplying fresh, high-quality protein to families in need.

"The sale has always been about teaching youth responsibility and giving back to the community," said organizers from the Blue Valley Farm Show. "Now, through this partnership with Feeding Pennsylvania, the generosity putting farm-fresh meat on the tables of families who need it most."

On Saturday, 15 animals were donated to the food bank, a remarkable demonstration of community support. These contributions not only benefit local families but also highlight the commitment of area buyers to both agriculture and food security.

The Youth Livestock Sale continues to be a highlight of the Blue Valley Farm Show, bringing together 4-H members, families, and local businesses. With the addition of Feeding Pennsylvania, the event expands its reach beyond the showgrounds, reinforcing the spirit of community that the fair has celebrated for generations.


