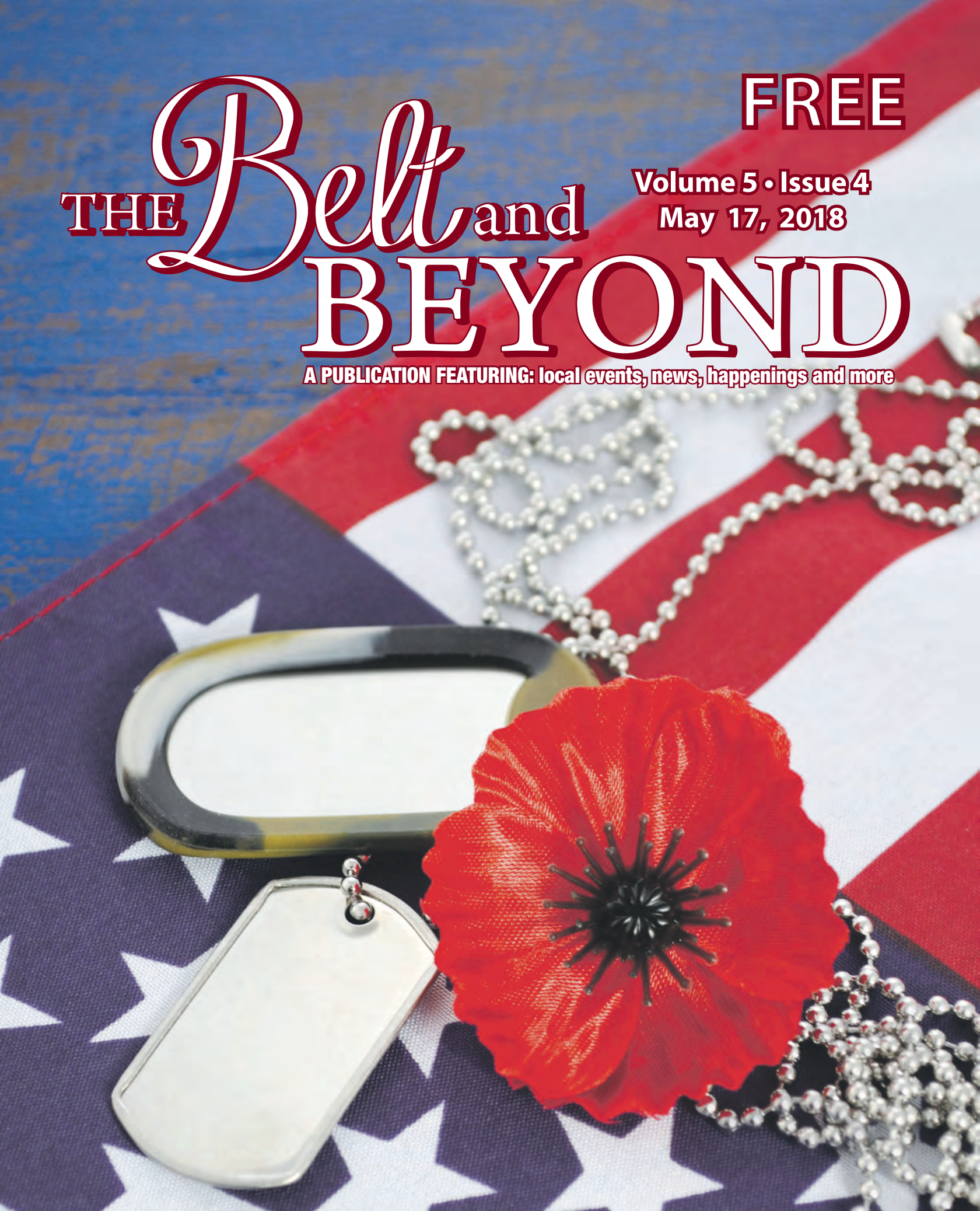

The event included tours of the facility, refreshments and excited discussions about the future of the Slate Belt YMCA.

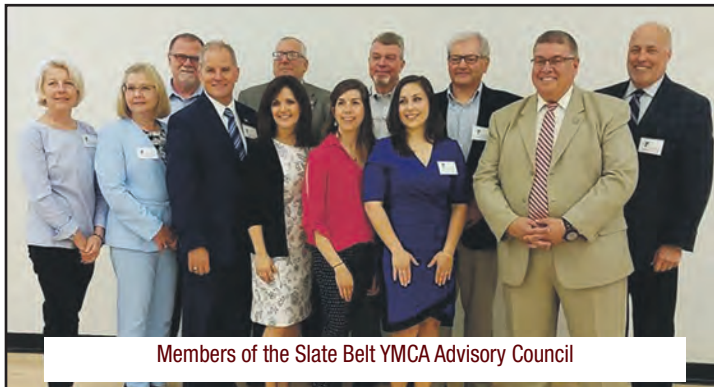

The soil under Minsi Lake has been submerged for almost 50 years. Plants and animals have thickened the lakebed, adding fragments of themselves to the muddy morass. This bit of biologic richness will be exposed until the empty lake basin refills with water late next year.

In that mud lies a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to create a unique piece of artwork. Your Minsi mud painting will remain dry on land long after the water returns to the lake. ### RED, WHITE & BLUE Cherry Pie

Celebrate Memorial Day with this red, white and blue pie!

#### Ingredients

- |  |                             |

| 1 box refrigerated pie crust, room temperature | 4 cups fresh cherries       |
| 1 cup sugar                                    | 1/2 teaspoon vanilla        |
| 4 tablespoons cornstarch                       | 1 1/2 cup fresh blueberries |

#### Directions:

1. Wash and pit the cherries
2. Place cherries in a large saucepan over medium heat, add 1 cup sugar, the vanilla, and the cornstarch
3. Cook Stirring frequently, until cherries have softened and the juices have thickened. Remove from heat and let cool.
4. in bowl toss blueberries with 1/2 cup of sugar.
5. Place one of the pie crusts in a pie pan and press carefully into pan and flute the edges with your fingers.
6. Prepare an 8x6-inch piece of aluminum foil by folding it in half two times until it measures 8x1½. (this will help to keep the berries separated). Fill the small side with the blueberries and the large side with the cherries. Remove the foil divider.
7. Take the second portion of the pie crust and cut out stars and stripes of various sizes to mimic the stars and stripes on the American flag.
8. Place the stars over the blueberries and the stripes over the cherries.
9. Cover the edges of the pie with aluminum foil and bake at 375 degrees for the first 30 minutes of baking, remove the foil and bake another 30 minutes'

For the margarita layer, add the ingredients, except for the blue food coloring. Pulse in the blender until smooth. Pour half of the margarita into a large cup or container and place in freezer. Color the remaining margarita with a few drops of blue food coloring until you get your desired shade of blue.

Run a slice of lime around the edge of each glass and dip into either salt or sugar.

Carefully spoon each flavor into the glasses, layering the colors. Serve immediately with a fresh lime slice. Serves 2



### 16-Year-Old Student To Design Next Easton Mural

At just 16-years-old, Madison Scott will be the next featured artist for the Easton Murals Project.

Scott began work on Sunday, May 6, to start outlining her mural onto the retaining wall at the corner of Spring Garden Street and Larry Holmes Drive. The mural is supported by a Main Street Foundation grant through the Greater Lehigh Valley Chamber of Commerce. The wall is co-owned by Clay Mitman, of Berkshire Hathaway HomeServices and Tomias Hinchcliff, owner of Genesis Bicycles. The mural will be painted and completed around Scott's school schedule, with a tentative end date of May 25, 2018.

Scott is a student at Delaware Valley Regional High School, who plans to major in business and marketing. She was inspired to enter Easton Murals Project's call for artists after co-founder Chaz Hampton spoke at her school. Scott explains that the wall's location and unusual 110' x 6'-foot shape made it fitting for a mural that celebrates the importance, beauty and power of the confluence of the Delaware and Lehigh rivers - a confluence that defines Easton.



"I call my mural 'Sipu' - as this is the Lenape word for river," Scott explained on her application. "This is in honor of the first people who

settled in Easton. The rivers connect the past, present and future. My mural is meant to honor that."

In 2016, Scott was the recipient of the NAWBO (National Association of Women Business Owners) Central Jersey Barbara A. Fuller SEED Award, presented to a New Jersey entrepreneur between the ages of 10-18. Scott sells her artwork at local stores and craft fairs, with her designs printed on phone cases, stickers, t-shirts and cards.

Scott sees public art as a way of establishing a sense of community and a sense of place.

"The Easton Murals committee was blown away by Madison and her mural proposal," said Chaz Hampton. "She's a talented and dynamic young woman who embodies all of the characteristics of the emerging artists we developed this program to support."

The Easton Murals Project is a collaboration between Brick + Mortar Gallery owners, Chaz Hampton and Tom D'Angelo, and Easton Main Street Initiative. This will be the third installation, following on the heels of the Giancarlo DeMarchi's 49 N. Bank St. work, and Scott Albrecht's 118-120 Northampton St. mural.
